

PRIVACY POLICY

Who we are

The Pet Dental Scoring (PDS) is a free web application supporting dog owners to perform a dental assessment for their animals. Copyright, right of ownership and right of use belong to Dr. Gottfried Morgenegg-Wegmüller. Internet privacy

The PDS web application displaying this privacy policy (referred to hereafter as “policy”) undertakes to collect, keep and protect your personal information in accordance with this policy and the laws, rules and regulations applicable.

This privacy policy applicable to Pet Dental Scoring (referred to hereafter as “PDS” or “us”) sets out how PDS collects, uses and shares personal information, referred to as personally identifying information, such as your name, postal address, e-mail address and telephone number.

Processing entity

The Pet Dental Scoring, situated at Dorfstrasse 70, CH-8912 Obfelden, Switzerland is responsible for processing personal information provided to “PDS”.

Consent

Only information you have voluntarily provided is collected by PDS. When, using the reminder service, you provide this required or optional information subject to positive confirmation of submission, you consent to PDS collecting, using and disclosing this information in accordance with the provisions of this Privacy Policy.

You can choose not to provide certain information but if you do so, you may not be able to access some of the services and functions we offer.

Collection and use of personal information

The use of the PDS is free and anonymous. We do not collect personal data during normal use.

We are able to collect your personal data when you give us this information voluntarily:

- You ask us questions by e-mail. You may then be able to exercise the right to access and correct such information with the dedicated PDS contact at contact@e-vds.vet.
- You apply for our reminder service by giving us your e-mail address.

Your personal information will only be used and disclosed by PDS and the persons and organisations working for it in accordance with this policy and any other privacy notice applicable, and according to the express authorisations or requirements of the laws, rules and regulations applicable.

Note that PDS does not sell or pass on your personal information to entities. For the purposes of security and if the law requires this, PDS reserves the right to disclose personal information about you, including your e-mail address, for notification to government authorities, the parties involved in legal proceedings by order of the competent court or tribunal and otherwise if expressly required or authorized by the law applicable.

Except in the circumstances mentioned in this policy, your personal information will not be shared without your consent and is only used by and for the business purposes of PDS as explained.

Protection of personal information

We maintain physical and electronic security measures and back-up procedures for the collection, storage and communication of customers' personal information. Our security procedures may require us to ask you for proof of identity before we can give you your personal information.

It is important to protect yourself from unauthorized access to your computer password. If you share a computer, you must log off after each use. It is your responsibility to protect your own copies of your passwords and log-in details allowing you to access our on-line resources.

Access to your personal information and correction:

- In compliance with the Data Protection Act 1998 (DPA) requirements, anyone who has provided personal information can obtain details of such information and, where applicable, correct or delete it, by contacting with the subject header 'Unsubscribe'.

Cookies

The PDS web application does not use any cookies.

Your rights relating to personal data

You have the following rights under the GDPR, in certain circumstances and subject to certain exemptions, in relation to your personal data:

- Right to access the data – you have the right to request a copy of the personal data that we hold about you, together with other information about our processing of that personal data.
- Right to rectification – you have the right to request that any inaccurate data that is held about you is corrected, or, if we have incomplete information, you may request that we update the information such that it is complete.
- Right to erasure – you have the right to request us to delete personal data that we hold about you.
- Right to restriction of processing, or, to object to processing – you have the right to request that we no longer process your personal data for particular purposes, or, to object to our processing of your personal data for particular purposes.
- Right to data portability – you have the right to request us to provide you with a copy of your personal data in a structured, commonly used machine-readable format.

In order to exercise any of the rights set out above, please contact us at the contact details at the start of this privacy notice.

If we are processing personal data based on your consent, you may withdraw that consent at any time. This does not affect the lawfulness of processing which took place prior to its withdrawal.

If you are unhappy with how we process personal data, we ask you to contact us so that we can rectify the situation.

You may lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority. The Swiss Data Protection Commission: *Commission fédérale de la protection des données et de la transparence*.

Updating our Privacy Policy

PDS may revise this policy from time to time and reserves the right to amend this privacy statement or add or remove parts of it at its discretion.

Any change we decide to make to this policy will be displayed on this web application, so you will always be able to check what information we collect, how we might use such information and whether or not we will share it with any other entity.
